

MoDOT's Ready-to-Go Transportation Projects

The following list of transportation improvements represents the projects MoDOT is getting ready in anticipation of the passage of the Economic Recovery Act. This proposed legislation is a jobs bill – not a transportation bill. It requires half of the transportation funds be spent in 90 to 180 days. If they are not, the funds are redistributed to other states meeting this objective. The remaining funds must be spent by August 2010. Timeliness of project delivery is the act's key objective. This list of projects totals more than the transportation funding Missouri anticipates receiving from the Economic Recovery Act. This was done so Missouri can be ready to spend additional funds should they be available from changes to the draft legislation or from any redistribution of funds at a later date. All projects are to be 100 percent federally funded and must meet all federal requirements. When the legislation is passed, MoDOT will need to modify the direction and determine the specific projects that can be built based on the estimates provided here and on Missouri's allocation. These choices will be made in cooperation with MoDOT's regional planning partners.

District 1

Atchison County, Route 136 – Painting, redeck and bridge repairs of Missouri River bridge at Brownville, Nebraska.

Clinton County, Route 35 – Resurface northbound and southbound lanes from north of Shoal Creek to north of Route 116 near Lathrop.

District 2

Adair County, Route 63 – Construct 6 miles of new two-lane roadway on fourlane right of way on the east side of Kirksville from Benton Way to Eagle Lane.

District 4 (Rural)

Lafayette County, Route 70 – Pavement improvements on the eastbound and westbound lanes from the Jackson County line to Odessa.

Platte County, Route 29 – Resurface pavement and shoulders on northbound and southbound lanes at various locations from Route 273 to Vivion Road (rural share).

Clay County, Route 210 – Widen to four lanes from Eldon Road to Route 291.

Jackson County, Route 150 – Widen from two lanes to four lanes from Horridge Road to Route 291.

Platte County, Route 29 – Resurface pavement and shoulders on northbound and southbound lanes at various locations from Route 273 to Vivion Road. (urban share)

Jackson County, Route 435/70 Interchange – Construct new half diamond interchange at Route 40/I-435, replace Blue Ridge Cut-off bridge over I-70, add lanes to I-70 and modify some ramps.

Benton County, Routes 83/65/7 – Painting and/or rehabilitation of bridges on Route 83 over Truman Lake near Mockingbird Road, Route 65 over the Osage River near Warsaw and Route 7 over Truman Lake (Osage Arm bridge and Grand River Arm bridge).

Boone County, Route 63/COLT Railroad – Build railroad bridge over Route 63 north of Route B in Columbia.

St. Charles, Route 364 – Extend Page Avenue from 0.4 mile east of Jungermann and accelerate from Woodstream to Woodstone.

St. Louis County, Route 141 – Construct Route 141 on relocation from Route 340 to St. Luke’s Hospital Drive.

St. Louis City, Route 70 – Pavement improvement from Poplar Street Bridge to Washington Avenue.

Barry/Lawrence/Christian/Greene Counties, Route 60 – Construct alternating/intermittent passing lanes from east of Chapell Drive in Monett to Kansas Avenue in Republic.

Barton/Bates Counties, Route 71 – Convert four at-grade intersections at Route 52, Route 126, Routes DD/EE and Routes V/C to interchanges as part of the upgrade to I-49.

McDonald County, Route 71 – Construct freeway from Pineville to Arkansas state line.

District 8 (Urban)

Greene County, Route 65 – Widen to six lanes from I-44 to Route 60 (James River Freeway).

Crawford County, Route 44 – Pavement rehabilitation on westbound lanes from 0.6 mile west of Route H to the Phelps County line.

Phelps County, Route 44 – Major pavement rehabilitation/reconstruction on westbound lanes from Business Loop 44 (Rolla) to Sugartree Road interchange.

Pemiscot County, Route 55 – Pavement rehabilitation on northbound lanes from Arkansas state line to I-155.
