




Comparison of 2002 State System Road Miles


Comparison of 2002 State Population




Missouri Department of Transportation Revenue and Disbursements for Road and Bridges Fiscal Years 2002-2004



Missouri Department of Transportation FY04 Revenue & Disbursements (Millions)




FY 04 Revenue & Bond Proceeds \$1,993 Million




FY 04 Disbursements (Budget Basis) \$1,967 Million


