**ADDENDUM 001
REQUEST FOR BIDS
Plant Mix Oil Material, El Dorado Springs
Request for Bid D7-11-024**

Bidders should acknowledge receipt of Addendum 001 (ONE) by signing and including it with the original bid. The due date for receipt of bids remains unchanged by this Addendum. Accordingly, the following clarifications, questions and answers, and revision are believed to be of general interest to all potential Bidders. All other terms and conditions remain unchanged and in full force.

QUESTION 1: It is unclear to us whether or not Ash Grove aggregates is supplying the rock for the cold mix or do we have to purchase the rock from ash grove aggregates?

ANSWER: MoDOT will be purchasing the aggregate and oil from the awarded bidder. The aggregate will have to be purchased, mixed to create the pre-mix and then sold to MoDOT. The cost of the rock is to be included in the price of the plant mix oil material submitted to MoDOT.

QUESTION 2: Can the contractor move in and pug all 2300 tons at once and leave in a stockpile or is it on an as needed basis?

ANSWER: The entire 2300 tons will be stockpiled.

QUESTION 3: In reference to paragraph 2.1.4, does that mean the contractor has to be off-site and cold mix completely finished by April 4, 2011?

ANSWER: Yes, that is what that paragraph is saying. However, MoDOT has determined that the total 2300 tons does not have to be stockpiled by April 4th, 2011. Paragraph 2.1.4 is being revised to say the following:

REVISION:

Paragraph 2.1.4 is to be removed and replaced with the following.

The stockpile is to consist of 1000 tons by April 4th, 2011. The remaining 1300 tons is to be stockpiled by April 18, 2011, bringing the full completion of the stockpile to be in place by April 18th, 2011.
