How may I review a copy of the Environmental Assessment (EA) for the Route 5 Hurricane Deck Bridge in Camden County?

The environmental assessment is now available for public review and was prepared in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), the National Historic Preservation Act, 23 CFR 771, and regulations of the Council on Environmental Quality, to provide guidance in determining the appropriate actions needed to address this bridge. **The document can be viewed at tonight's public hearing.
