# Route 5 Shared Four-Lane

## Project Description.

Grading, drainage, bridges and paving for a new shared four-lane highway, which consists of alternating passing lanes along a conventional two-lane highway.

The shared four-lane provides motorists with periodic opportunities to pass other vehicles without having to drive in the opposing lane.

## Location.

This portion of the project stretches from Camdenton to the Laclede County line. An additional ten miles of shared four-lane is currently under construction on Route 5 from the county line to the City of Lebanon.

## Length.

18 miles total, from Camdenton to Lebanon

## Contractors.

**Dave Kolb Grading, Inc. of St. Charles, Mo.** graded eight miles of new highway from Camdenton to just south of the Laclede County line. Award Date: April 9, 2008.

**Emery Sapp and Sons, Columbia, Mo.** completed the paving work on this portion of the shared four-lane, and will complete paving work on the Laclede County portion in early 2011. Award Date: July 9, 2009.

## Award Cost.

\$20.4 million for Camden County work  
\$7.2 million for Laclede County work
