About the Project


As MoDOT upgrades the current traffic signal system at the intersection of U.S. Route 50, Route 5 and Route B in Tipton as part of its maintenance schedule, a new “Yield on Flashing Yellow Arrow” traffic display is being implemented to provide safer left turns for motorists.

The work also includes replacing existing wooden poles and span wires with more durable steel poles and mast arms to hold the signal heads.

What is a Flashing Yellow Arrow?


A flashing yellow arrow indication means left turns are allowed, but you must first yield to oncoming traffic and pedestrians and proceed with caution. It replaces the

traditional “Left Turn Yield On Green” indication currently used for dedicated left-turn lanes.



Understanding the Flashing Yellow Arrow

Remember: flashing yellow = proceed with caution



A solid red light means STOP.

Drivers turning left must stop and wait.


A solid yellow arrow warns drivers the left-turn signal is about to go red and they should prepare to stop, or prepare to complete their left turn if they are within the intersection.

A flashing yellow arrow means turns are permitted, but you must first yield to oncoming traffic and pedestrians and then proceed with caution. Oncoming traffic has a green light.


A solid green arrow means it is safe to turn left. Oncoming traffic must stop.





