Ribbon Cutting for
U.S. Route 65
Widening through Lincoln
in Benton County

The Missouri Department of Transportation invites you to celebrate the completion of a \$3.8 million project to widen nearly two miles of U.S. Route 65 through the City of Lincoln in Benton County.

A ribbon-cutting ceremony will take place at 11 a.m. on Tuesday, Sept. 28, 2010 at the MoDOT facility in Lincoln. Guests should park at the facility located on Route 65 just north of the Route 65 and C intersection. The ceremony will be held rain or shine.

The project extends from 1.75 miles south of Route HH to north of Route H. The new highway includes two southbound and two northbound lanes, along with a center-turn lane.

This work is part of a larger project to improve Route 65 through Benton County, from just south of Route 52 to just north of the Osage River in Warsaw. A \$19.3 million project to widen 13 miles of Route 65 to four lanes began in July 2010. When completed, the new divided highway will have two northbound and two southbound lanes.
