





About the Project

Project Description:

The two bridges, over Bonne Femme Creek and Bonne Femme Creek Overflow, are located just west of Route 124. The previous structures were built in 1932. Both were completely replaced, one half at a time, in order to allow traffic to continue to use Route 240 during construction. The bridge closest to Route 124 was also widened to accommodate a left turn lane for vehicles turning from Route 240.
