Dear Mr. Rahn:

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and Federal Transit Administration (FTA) have reviewed Missouri Department of Transportation's (MoDOT) request to incorporate the Mid-America Regional Council's (MARC) modification of their FY 2008-2012 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), as further described in your letter of July 1, 2009, as an amendment to the FY 2009-2013 Missouri Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The modifications to be amended into the STIP includes the addition of 12 new local public agency sponsored highway and transit projects, along with modifications to two other local public agency sponsored transportation projects. Eight of the 12 new highway and transit projects are being funded with American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Recovery Act) funding. Seven of the 8 new highway and transit projects are located within an economically distressed area (EDA).

The MARC Board of Directors approved this TIP amendment on May 26, 2009. The Missouri Governor approved the MARC's amendment on June 30, 2009.

In accordance with 23 CFR 450.218(b), we have determined that this STIP amendment is based on a transportation planning process that substantially meets the requirements of 23 U.S.C 134 and 135, 49 U.S.C. 5303 and 5304 and 23 CFR 450 Subparts A, B, and C. Based on our review, this STIP amendment request is approved.
