## Route FF (32nd Street) at Flying J Jasper/Newton County

### What is MoDOT doing on Route FF at Flying J?

Widening Route FF slightly to install raised concrete medians in front of Flying J's entrances to restrict left turns out of Flying J. This will also restrict left turns into and out of Oak Park Drive (residents on Oak Park Drive will use Bedford Place for access).

An access road will be built east of the truck stop so trucks exiting Flying J can turn left at the southbound ramp signal.

### What impact will the road work have on travel?

At least one lane of Route FF will be closed during construction. Crews will not close lanes from 7-8 a.m. and from 3-6 p.m. to try to avoid peak traffic times.

### What's the time frame?

MoDOT plans to award the project this fall. Construction would be complete by the end of 2011.

### What is the estimated cost?

\$800,000-900,000
