The Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission is requesting the services of a consulting engineering firm to perform the described professional services for the project included on the attached list.



Limit your letter of interest to no more than four pages. This letter should include a statement to indicate why your firm is interested in the project. Experience with Practical Design will be a major factor in the selection for these services. Therefore the letter should focus on the experience your firm has with Practical Design that makes it best qualified for this selection. It should also include any other information which might help us in the selection process, such as the persons or team you would assign to each project, the backgrounds of those individuals, and other projects your company has recently completed or are now active. We will utilize the consultant information already on file so we will not need a lengthy submittal of other general company information.

DBE firms must be certified by the Missouri Department of Transportation in order to be counted as participation towards an established DBE Goal. We encourage DBE firms to submit letters of interest as prime consultants for any projects they feel can be managed by their firm.

MoDOT will evaluate firms based on: Past Performance Emphasizing Practical Design, Qualifications of Personnel Assigned, Capability of Firm and Staff, Accessibility of Firm & Staff.

We request all letters be received by 3:00 pm, August 15, 2012 at the appropriate office.
