

## Franklin Boonville Historic Marker Howard County, Missouri:

The Marker site is located just off Route 87 north of Boonville. Parts from the former historic Boonville Bridge were set aside prior to the demolition of the bridge, and have been used at the site. Sections of the original guardrail and a bridge name plate can be viewed there.
