Beginning 5 - Lane Area

To avoid a county-owned park, the new alignment can be adjusted within existing right of way

Ending 5 - Lane Area

To avoid two section 4(f) properties through Vichy, the study team conducted an analysis and determined the existing highway should be widened to the west

Alternative 1 was not recommended as the preferred for the following reasons:
* Does not utilize recent improvements made along existing alignment through town
* Does not utilize intersection improvements at Route 68 and Route 63
* Significantly more costs than widening along the existing route

This alternative was recommended as the preferred for the following reasons:
* Uses the recently upgraded segment through Vichy
* Existing alignment through Vichy is relatively flat and can be widened to the west for a five-lane section, making this segment less costly

Alternative 2 was not recommended as the preferred for the following reasons:
* Negatively affects 2 historical properties on the east side of Vichy
* Requires right of way on the east side; resulting in more costs

From the Maries/Phelps County line, the existing alignment and roadway can be used and expanded to the west within existing right of way with no additional impacts.
