



Route A Safety Improvement Project

Why Does Route A in Franklin County Need Improvement?

- Route A from Chamber Drive in Washington to north of Independence Drive in Union needs safety improvements to help with the state's plan of fewer crashes on minor roads.
- MoDOT needs to improve the condition of this section of Route A to provide a safer connection to major road system.
- MoDOT's goal is to improve Franklin County motorists' travel on this road.

What is the proposed solution?

- Perform asphalt resurfacing, shoulder improvements (11-foot lanes, 2-foot shoulders) and edgeline rumble stripes along this stretch of highway.
- Improve curves between Pottery Road and Spring Hill Road.
- Perform alignment improvements in the following locations:
 - Shift Route A toward the north between Summer Hill Road and Pottery Lane
 - Shift Route A toward the west along curve near Four mile road intersection.
 - Improve traffic flow on Route BB intersection
- Driveway culverts located within state right of way will be replaced if in bad condition or if widening requires relocation of the culvert. Culverts located outside state right of way won't be replaced unless necessary to accommodate shoulder slope modifications.

What are the benefits?

- These improvements will increase safety and traffic flow along Route A.
- This project is part of a statewide plan to improve minor roads.
